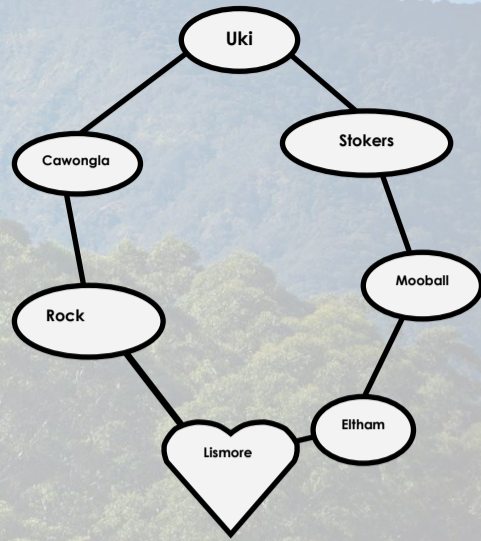

Lismore, Rock Valley, Uki Loop

170km

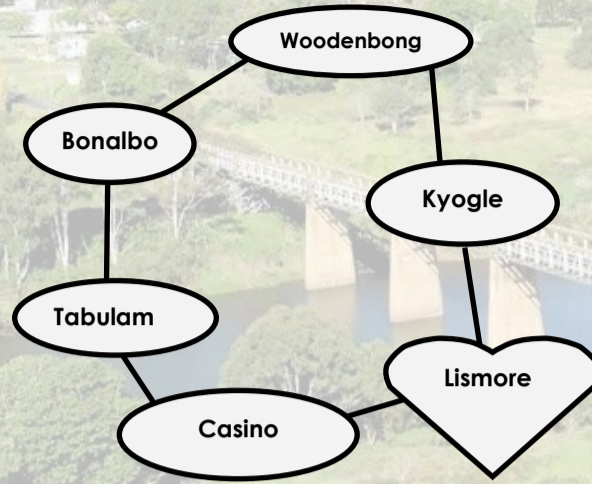
Take a ride along Leicester Creek past the Rock Valley Post Office, one of the smallest post offices in Australia. Explore the spectacular scenery and ranges formed by the extinct shield volcano millions of years ago. This ride has many unique and interesting café's and pubs to call into along the way.



Lismore, Tabulam & Woodenbong Loop

270km

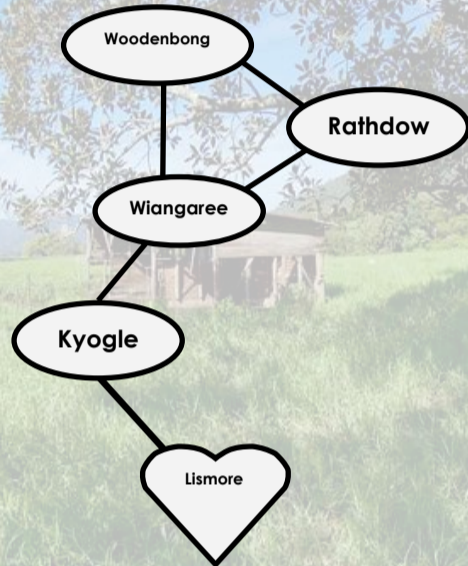
Casino and Tabulam are known for their cattle farming and beautiful rural landscapes. This ride takes in the country charm of the region. Winding through farmland, small townships and native forests. The ever-changing scenery on this ride makes it a must do.



Lismore, Kyogle & Lions Road Loop

260km

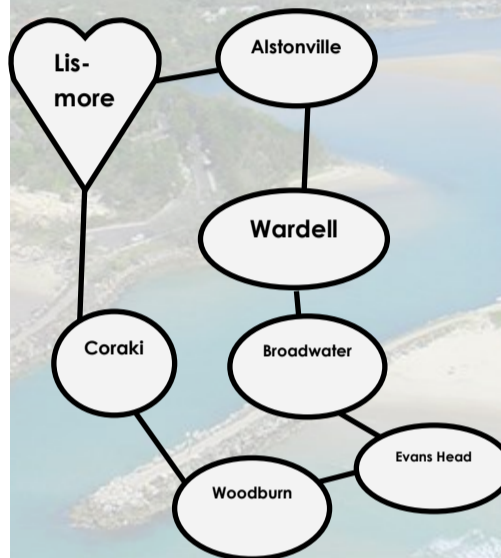
Discover the historic Lions Road. Winding over the Border Ranges through to Rathdowney the Lions Road is full of breathtaking scenery, ranges and rocky outcrops. The twists and turns make this route a very popular ride for bike riders in the region. Explore towns along the way including Kyogle, Rathdowney and Woodenbong.



Lismore, Alstonville & Evans Head Loop

120km

From the plateau to the coast this ride has it all. Start off with a ride through the historic town of Alstonville. Take a scenic windy ride down from the plateau to river town of Wardell. Follow the highway to Broadwater home of the Broadwater Sugar Mill and then on to Evans Head. Return via Woodburn, Coraki and Wyrallah which are all important river ports from the days of river transport.



Bexhill, Clunes and Eltham Loop

45km

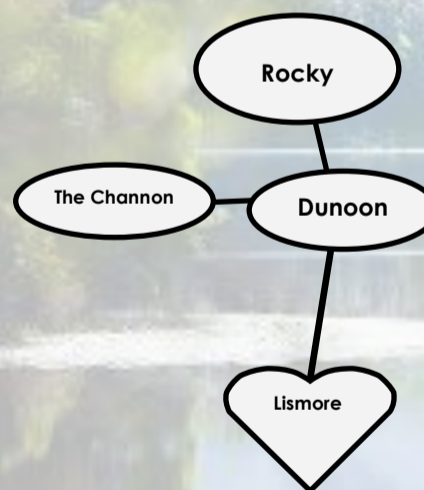
Enjoy the panoramic view from the Open Air Cathedral in Bexhill. Call into Clunes and visit the general store equip with a café and cellars specialising in locally produced beer, wine and spirits. Wind down the hill to Eltham a historic railway town with a great pub to enjoy lunch.



Dunoon, Rocky Creek Dam and The Channon Loop

60km

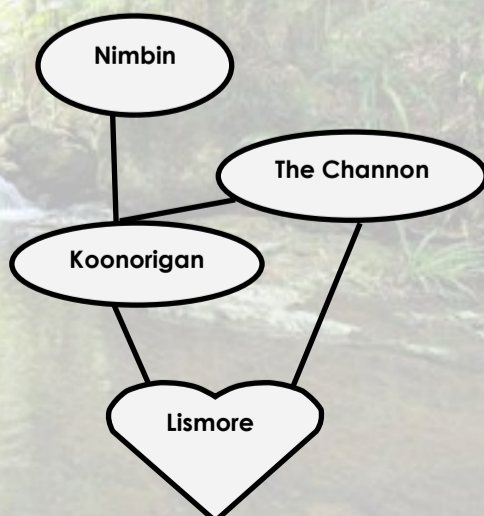
Explore the rainforest and see why Dunoon is known as the macadamia capital of Australia. Rocky Creek Dam stores the water for the region and has beautiful bushwalks around the dam and rainforest. The Channon is known for it's market on the second Sunday of every month and has a great Tavern for lunch.



The Channon, Koonorigan and Nimbin Loop

72km

The Channon is known for it's market on the second Sunday of every month and has a great Tavern and General Store. The Koonorigan Range has breathtaking views over the ranges and valleys. Ride past the Nimbin rocks and into Nimbin. Nimbin is known for it's alternative culture. Explore the streets filled with cafes galleries and unique shops.



Bangalow, Newrybar and Tintenbar Loop

77km

The ride from Lismore to Bangalow is a scenic winding road through lush green hills. Bangalow's main street has an array of boutique stores and cafes. Newrybar is a historic town now home to antique stores, retro stores and a beautiful café, bakery and deli. The Old Pacific Highway now the Hinterland Way is a quite stretch of road with views over the coastline.



Lismore to Canungra Round Trip

340km

This is one of the best rides in the region! The road will take riders through Bangalow/Byron Bay, Mooball, Murwillumbah, and Chillingham to the picturesque township of Canungra. From here the road leads back to Nerang where the ride will continue down the Pacific Highway to Bangalow and back to Lismore. Alternatively, return to Lismore via Uki and Nimbin



Lismore to Kingscliff Round Trip

220km

This is a great coastal ride to take a passenger. Incredible coastal views, pubs, cafes, and good roads. Rode from Lismore to the coast and then ride over to Murwillumbah and Uki for a change of scenery over winding bush roads through the rolling hills back to Lismore.



Lismore to Yamba loop

228km

A great mid-morning or lunch ride. Explore the great coastal villages located on the mighty Clarence. You can catch the ferry from Illuka or Yamba and cross the Clarence River for a perfect round trip.



Lismore to Glen Innes

554km

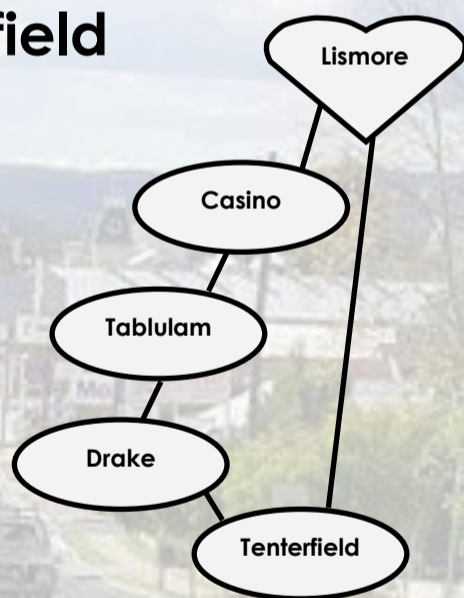
Highway riding at it's best! An easy ride to Grafton, followed by a ride up the Gwydir Highway to Glen Innes. From here take the New England Highway to Tenterfield and then meander down the Bruxner Highway through Casino and back to Lismore.



Lismore to Tenterfield

334km

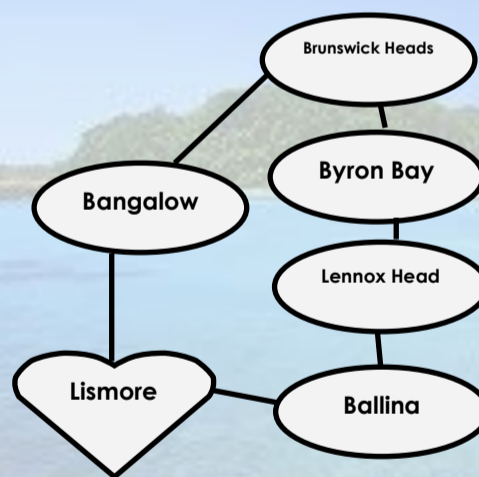
This ride takes you inland right through to Tenterfield, guaranteed to stratify all riders with it's twists and turns. Explore villages along the way and seek out the bike display at the pub in Drake. Take in the views of the spectacular coastal escarpment as you ride back to Lismore in time for dinner.



Lismore to Brunswick Heads

131km

A great short ride, head to Ballina from Lismore and take Tourist Drive 30 to Lennox Head, through to Byron Bay and Brunswick Heads. There are plenty of cafes, pubs and live music on weekends. Explore the hidden gems of Billinudgel, Ocean Shores and Mullumbimby. Bangalow is the final pit stop on the way back to Lismore



Lismore to Warwick to Tenterfield

Varied distances

Take your time exploring the country. The section from Woodenbong to Legume might slow you down a bit but don't let that deter you. Test out the great gravel sections between Tenterfield and Bald Rock National Park. Here are a few route options:

1. Lismore, Warwick, Lismore: **384km**
2. Lismore, Legume, Bald Rock, Tenterfield, Lismore: **416km**
3. Lismore, Legume, Bald Rock, Stanthorpe, Tenterfield, Lismore **488km**
4. Lismore, Warwick, Tenterfield, Lismore: **470km**
